The **7000 RPM Leadership System™** was introduced as a structural model for evaluating the relationship between leadership alignment and organizational outcomes.

The framework focuses on three central forces:

- **Responsibility** — clear ownership of leadership roles and decisions
- **Purpose** — unified understanding of the organization's direction
- **Mission** — coordinated execution across leadership teams

When these forces rotate together, leadership operates as a synchronized system rather than isolated decision centers.

#### Framework Application

Leaders used the framework to examine key organizational areas:

- clarity of leadership responsibility
- consistency of mission communication
- coordination between departments
- alignment between leadership decisions and organizational strategy
